# CCS Catalog of State Actions

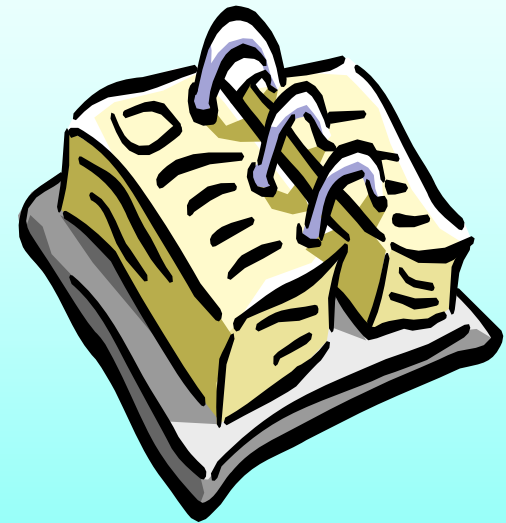
- Actions undertaken or considered by a wide variety of US states
