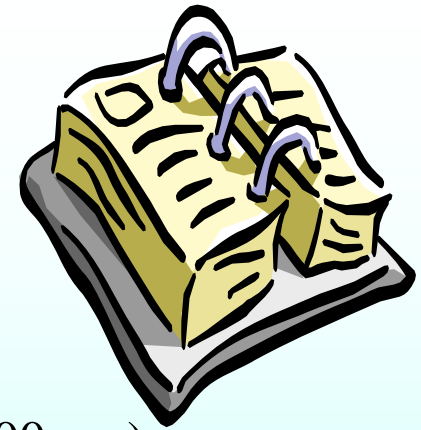

Stepwise Planning Process

1. Develop inventory and forecast of emissions
2. Identify a full range of possible actions
3. Identify initial priorities for analysis
4. Develop straw proposals
- 5. Quantify GHG reductions and costs/savings**
- 6. Evaluate externalities, feasibility issues**
- 7. Develop alternatives to address barriers**
8. Aggregate results
9. Iterate to final agreements
10. Finalize and report recommendations
